

PERSONS FALLING WITHIN THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES ARE ENTITLED TO BE INTERRED IN THE BURIAL GROUND

<u>Category</u>		<u>Scale of Fees to be Applied</u>
A	A person who at the time of death is an inhabitant of the civil parish of Bodicote	1
B	A person who at the time of death is an ex-parishioner having at least three years residence in the civil parish of Bodicote	2
C	A person who at the time of death is an ex-parishioner having at least three years residence in the civil parish of Bodicote, whose death has occurred within 12 months of vacating the Parish of Bodicote for reasons of ill-health requiring essential treatment and/or care	1
D	A person who is an immediate relative of a person buried in the burial ground. For this purpose an immediate relative means grandparent, parent, brother, sister, husband, wife, civil partner, child or grandchild.	2
E	A spouse of a person entitled to be interred in the burial ground falling within 1 category A above	1
F	A spouse of a person entitled to be interred in the burial ground falling within categories B or C above	2
G	A child under one month, including a stillborn child, who is an immediate relative (see category C above for definition) of a person who is either a resident of the civil parish, or an ex-parishioner of at least three years residence in the civil parish	2
	<i>In the case of a person falling in categories B, C, D, F & G, the Exclusive Right of Burial shall be purchased</i>

A	Is an inhabitant of the civil parish of Bodicote	1
B	Is an ex-parishioner of at least three years residence in the village	2
